## ABOUT THE PROJECT

After undergoing profound political transformations, the Danube region is now facing diverse demographic, labour market and migration challenges, yet lacks the appropriate multi-level governance support structures, especially in the field of migrant integration. The consortium of partners from nine countries (Slovenia, Croatia, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Austria, Germany, Slovak Republic, Czech Republic, and Hungary) will address this challenge by creating a comprehensive, multilingual and transnational information platform DANUBE COMPASS to be used by public institutions, NGOs and newly arrived and resident migrants. This tool will be tested and mainstreamed to all levels of public institutions through workshops and trainings as well as promoted through a strategy addressing the importance of migrants' access to information.
